Faith Family Welcomes New Medical Director

After a prayerful and deliberate search process, Faith Family is pleased to announce that Dr. Parker Panovec has been chosen as the new Medical Director of Faith Family Medical Center. Dr. Panovec comes to Faith Family from Jackson, TN where he most recently worked for the Jackson Clinic in outpatient medicine and wound care.



Prior to this, he practiced both inpatient and outpatient family medicine at the University of Tennessee. Dr. Panovec attended Harding Academy, Lipscomb University, and UT Memphis College of Medicine, with a focus on family medicine. He was chosen as chief resident during his residency in Rome, Georgia and later taught the UT residency program in Jackson, TN. With a heart for teaching and a passion for serving, Faith Family is thrilled that Dr. Panovec will be taking over this very important role of Medical Director. Dr. Henderson will continue to see patients on a part time basis.

The circumstances leading to Dr. Panovec's discovery of Faith Family are something one might refer to as divine intervention - Dr. Panovec was informed about the position at Faith Family by two of his friends, each within 30 minutes of each other. After visiting the clinic for the very first time, he recalled saying to his wife, "This is something that God's calling my hand on." Dr. Panovec has been involved in mission work throughout his career and personal life, and sees Faith Family as the next natural step in the process. "You begin to look at meaning - what kind of an impact can you have on others for good?" he explained in a recent interview. 
those that need us, and I am humbled that I have been able to be involved in this work.

PATIENT STORY: DENISE M.



Denise came to Faith Family for the first time on March 28, 2013. She had been ignoring her health for a number of years because she was stuck in a bad relationship and struggling to leave. "When I looked in the mirror I couldn't look at myself," she explains. "After I left the relationship I finally saw myself for the first time." Seeing herself for the first time also meant taking care of her health for the first time and finding a way to support herself.

Denise found work as a delicatessen clerk at a grocery store, but the job did not offer benefits. Her brother and his wife were Faith Family patients, and they urged her to make an appointment.

Denise's first appointment was scheduled on her birthday, March 28th of this year. During that first visit Amy Jean, Physician's Assistant, came into the exam room and asked Denise if it was her birthday. "Amy said to me, I'm so sorry to have to give you this news on this day, but there is a tumor in your abdomen and you're going to need surgery." Denise told Amy that there was no need to apologize; she saw this as a gift. She had struggled for such a long time, and coming to Faith Family meant she was finally putting herself first and taking control of her life. Amy and Denise prayed together in the exam room, and surgery consultations were later arranged. Testing later revealed the tumor was benign.

"I get real emotional when I talk about how blessed I am," Denise explains, "I thought I would never be able to get my health taken care of." Faith Family was able to coordinate Denise's care and arrange surgery and follow up at a price she can afford. "I can't even explain it, but I'm always happy now. This is God's way of making good things happen."

HEALTH CARE REFORM - WHAT'S NEXT?

We want to assure you that we are keeping track of the many upcoming issues that will affect the patients at Faith Family Medical Center. Because you are an important partner in our work, we want to provide you with this current information.

How will the patients at Faith Family know what to do regarding the Affordable Care Act? Faith Family will have a full-time Certified Application Counselor onsite, whose sole responsibility will be to meet with patients to help them assess and evaluate their options under this new law. They will walk the patient through the online enrollment process and help them determine if they qualify for tax credits and/or cost sharing subsidies. If/when the patient obtains health insurance; our staff will assist them in transitioning to another provider who accepts insurance. This will then "free up spots" for those who will continue to need our services.

Why won't everyone have insurance? Who will fall thru the cracks? The Kaiser Family Foundation estimates that even after full implementation of the ACA, there will be approximately 200,000 in Middle Tennessee who will not have health insurance. Since Tennessee has chosen not to expand Medicaid, individuals who fall under 100% of federal poverty level (under \$23,550 for a family of 4) will not receive any subsidies or tax credits to purchase insurance on the Marketplace (or Exchange). Many of our patients fall in this category - they are typically hourly workers who are trying hard to make ends meet.

What is the timeframe for all of this? Enrollment begins October 1, 2013 and coverage begins January 1, 2014. Experts anticipate the enrollment process to take years. The need for a strong, privately supported, faith based compassionate health care safety net such as Faith Family is not going away. We are grateful for all that you do for our organization and welcome your questions and comments. Your continued support remains more critical than ever as we continue to provide quality health care to those who need it the most.

Pharmacy students and instructors from Belmont University helped patients review their medications, a dental hygienist from Interfaith Dental Clinic performed oral tests, retinal eye exams were conducted by Vanderbilt Ophthalmic Imaging Center, and foot exams as well as provider visits were offered. Nutrition classes and wellness assessments were also incorporated into the day. All of this was available to patients at no charge.
