Nashville, Tenn. – Faith Family Medical Center (FFMC) is pleased to be named as a recipient of a grant awarded by the West End Home Foundation to promote access to medical care specifically focused on improving access for seniors.

The West End Home Foundation, originally a residential organization, now focuses primarily on grantmaking to increase the availability and standard of resources for the elderly in the community.
