Dr. David Gaw, Dr. John Lamb, and Charlie Martin recognized a **significant need in our community**-more than *200,000 uninsured middle Tennesseans*. As experienced physicians and healthcare visionaries, they **believed** they could **make a difference** and they had the will and the desire to change Nashville's healthcare landscape by creating **Faith Family Medical Center**.

THEN- Faith Family opened its doors **October 8, 2001**, and only **one patient** showed up.



2023 Annual Revenues by Category






IT and Building




2023 Annual Expenses by Function
