PATIENT HIGHLIGHT

Jimmy, a faithful construction worker, was referred to our Journey to Wellness program after being diagnosed with pre-diabetes. He met with our dietitian to explore healthier meal options and brought his wife and children along to one of our family education sessions.

They learned how to cook nutritious meals together, and the experience brought them closer as a family.

Jimmy has since lost weight, lowered his A1C to a healthy range, and no longer needs medication.



The Journey to Wellness (J2W) program exists to help patients make lasting changes in their lifestyle and improve the management of their health problems. Faith Family Medical Center patients are invited to take a deeper look at their health and wellness goals by participating in the J2W program, which is offered to the patient at no cost.

Recently, I saw a patient I've treated for years, mostly for her diabetes. We see her frequently. She takes the bus to get here, so just coming to an appointment is a major commitment for her. At a previous visit, we gave her food bags and shared resources beyond just medical care. <u>During this particular visit, she shared that her grandson had passed away unexpectedly.</u>

She refused any financial help. At the end of our visit, I asked if I could pray for her, and I did. Then she turned around and prayed for me and my family. We were both in tears. That moment reminded me: I'm so often enriched by our patients. The people we serve don't just receive physical care—they share their lives, their hearts, and even their faith with us.

There's never a dull moment at Faith Family because you'll never know what new opportunities will be presented each day. I've enjoyed welcoming new providers and several new team members, whether clinical providers, medical assistants, nurses, or administrative staff. It's all been exciting as I've been working on the Tennessee Breast and Cervical Health Program with women who need preventive screenings. Soon, the rest of the clinic will be involved, and other providers will begin enrolling patients too. Through this program, we'll be able to provide free breast and cervical cancer screenings to eligible patients, which includes most of the population we serve.


VOLUNTEER PHYSICIAN HOURS


PHYSICIAN VOLUNTEERS


ANNUAL REVENUES BY CATEGORY




ANNUAL EXPENSES BY CATEGORY
